1. This writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned order dated 29.11.2023 (Annexure P-4).
2. Learned State counsel has pointed out that in the present case in view of the law laid down by the Hon'ble Division Bench of this Court in 'Paramjit Kumar Saroya Vs. Union of India and another', reported as 2016(3) RCR (Civil) 146, against the impugned order, an appeal would lie.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in view of the same, he seeks to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a statutory appeal.
4. In view of the above, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn, with the aforesaid liberty.
