1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 06.07.2023 passed in CWP-14068-2023.
2. Compliance report by way of affidavit of Ravinder Singh Arora, Sub Divisional Magistrate, Baba Bakala Sahib, filed in the Registry, is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.
3. Status/compliance report by way of short affidavit of Ghanshyam Thori, Deputy Commissioner, District Amritsar, filed in the Court today, is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.
4. Counsel for the respondents has submitted that the order dated 06.07.2023 passed in CWP-14068-2023 has since been complied with and necessary decision has already been made. Copy of the same has also been placed on record.
