1. On 07.03.2024, the following order was passed by this
Court:-

“Through the instant petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., prayer is made for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.510 dated 29.8.2023, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 of IPC, registered at Police Station Adampur, District Hisar.

The allegations against the present petitioner are that, she has uploaded false information on the Government portal, wherein, she has mentioned that her parents are dead, however, during enquiry, it is transpired that the parents of the petitioner are alive and the documents, which were uploaded, were infact were forged documents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, in his asking for the relief of anticipatory bail, submits that she has no concern with the portal from where the information was uploaded and she has never handed over any OTP(one time password) to the co-accused, to upload these alleged documents. Above all, even if the allegations are considered as a gospel truth, it is merely an attempt to procure the certificate of 'Backward Class'.

Notice of motion for 2.4.2024.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Bhupender Singh, DAG, Haryana-accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

In the meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to her furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall, however, join the investigation as and when called for and shall also abide by the conditions specified under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C."

2. Learned State counsel, on instructions imparted to him by SI Surender, submits that the petitioner has already joined the investigation in pursuance to the aforesaid order, and he has fully co-operated with the investigation process, and is no more required for any further custodial investigation.

3. In view of the specific stand taken by the learned State counsel, the present petition is **allowed**, and order dated 07.03.2024 is, hereby, made absolute, on the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
