1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C with a prayer to grant the concession of interim regular bail to him for a period of four weeks, in a case arising out of FIR No. 211 dated 20.07.2023 under Sections 15,18,27,29 and 31 of NDPS Act and under Section 25 of Arms Act and under Section 406 of IPC, Police Station STF Phase IV, SAS Nagar, Mohali, District SAS Nagar, to attend the marriage of his brother namely Jackey Shroff, which is scheduled to be solemnized on 24.03.2024.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the marriage of brother of petitioner is scheduled to be solemnized on 24.03.2024 and has relied upon card of the marriage Annexures P-2 and P-3 in this regard. Apart from that, learned counsel for the petitioner has also placed reliance on the certificate, Annexure P-4 issued by the Gram Panchayat, Village Tarkhan Majra, Block Samana, District Patiala certifying the said fact.

3. A short reply by way of an affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Special Task Force, Patiala Range, Patiala has been filed on behalf of respondent-State and the same is taken on record.

4. Learned State counsel submits that the verification regarding the marriage of Jackey Shroff, brother of petitioner was got conducted through police official and a report (Annexure R-1) has been prepared in this regard. From the statements of family members of both the parties and the Gram Panchayat, it has been found that the marriage of Jackey Shroff, brother of petitioner has been fixed for Sunday i.e on 24.03.2024 with Pinki Kaur daughter of Teja Singh, resident of Village Tulewal, Police Station Sadar Samana, Patiala.

4. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record carefully.

5. In view of the submissions made by learned counsel for the parties, the petitioner is ordered to be released on interim bail at 10:00 AM on 19.03.2024 subject to his furnishing necessary surety bonds/bail bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate/CJM. The concerned Court may insist on two heavy local sureties in the present case.

6. The petitioner is directed to surrender at 05:00 PM on 26.03.2024 at the jail gate.

7. The petition stands allowed in the abovesaid terms.
