This is a contempt petition filed under Article 215 of the Constitution of India read with Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for disobeying the order dated 06.12.2023 passed in CWP-27331-2023.

Compliance report by way of affidavit of respondent No.1 has been filed today in the Court. The same is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan the same and place it at appropriate place.
