1. Present writ petition has been filed by workman-Kali Parsad Jha, assailing the award dated 26.03.1997 (Annexure P-1) passed by Industrial Tribunal-cum-Labour Court, Faridabad, whereby reference No.449 of 1988 has been answered against him and respondent No.2-M/s Flexibles, 63-A, Industrial Area, N.I.T., Faridabad/Management has been held entitled to recover an amount of Rs.10,500/- with interest @ 12% per annum from the date of its default.

2. Perusal of the paper-book reveals that the present writ petition is pending since the year 1998 (for the last about 26 years) and no stay order is ever passed.

3. Despite being informed, no one has appeared from either side. In the absence of parties, this Court is unable to decide, as to whether, with the efflux of time, any substantial issue for its adjudication , survives or not.
4. Dismissed for non-prosecution.
5. However, petitioner will be at liberty to move an application for revival of the present writ petition within eight weeks from today, in case any substantial issue warranting its decision, still survives.
