1. This is an application filed under Order 23 Rule 1 read with Section 151 CPC for withdrawal of main writ petition in view of the compromise deed dated 12.12.2023.
2. Learned counsel for the applicant-petitioner has submitted that the main case is listed for 06.08.2024 and now, the applicant-petitioner wishes to withdraw the main case as compromise has been effected between the parties.
3. For the reasons stated in the application which is duly supported by an affidavit, the present application is allowed and the date of hearing in the main case is preponed from 06.08.2024 to today and the same

is taken on Board today itself for final disposal.

Main case

1. This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside/quashing the order dated 21.06.2022 (Annexure P-1) passed by respondent No.2-Maintenance Tribunal as well as the order dated 29.11.2022 (Annexure P-2) passed by respondent No.1-Appellate Tribunal.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present writ petition in view of compromise deed dated 12.12.2023 (Annexure A-1).
3. In view of the above, the present Civil Writ Petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
4. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand disposed of in view of the abovesaid order.
