1. It is a burnt case.
2. Since there was no representation on behalf of the appellant, on 15.01.2024, the matter was adjourned and the counsel was informed but there was no representation on behalf of counsel for the appellant as is evident from order dated 19.01.2024. As per note of the Registry, name of the counsel for the appellant was not available in the Bar directory and place of sitting was also unknown. Appellant was ordered to be summoned at the given address.
3. Again per note of the Registry, notice was sent to the appellant, which has been received back unserved with the report that no such person is residing at the given address.



4. This Court does not have the latest address of the appellant. Given the prevailing circumstances, there seems to be no justification to keep the appeal on the docket, indefinitely. Consequently, this appeal stands dismissed in default, with liberty to the appellant to revive the same if has any grievance from this order.
