1. Counsel for the petitioner submits that both the petitioners are more than 18 years of age and are in live in relationship against the wishes of respondents No.5 to 8 who are extending threats to the petitioners and in this regard representation Annexure P-3 dated 27.02.2024 was given to respondent No.2 but the police authorities failed to take any action.

2. Notice of motion.

3. Mr. Viney Phogat, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of State of Punjab. He submits that the concerned authority will look into the matter and take decision on the representation of the petitioners in accordance with law.

4. In view of above, without going into the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with direction to Senior Superintendent of

Police, Fatehabad to consider representation dated 27.02.2024 (Annexure P-3) and to take action if so warranted in accordance with law.

5. However, any observations made in this order will not be construed as an expression of opinion on the validity of the relationship of the petitioners. It is also made clear that respondents No.5 to 8 are at liberty to avail appropriate remedy available to them under law against the petitioners. In case the petitioners have committed any offence, law will take its own course.
