PANKAJ JAIN, J. (Oral)

1. Present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.0213 dated 24.06.2019, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 186, 307, 332, 353, 411, 412, 420, 467, 468 and 471 of IPC and Sections 25/54/59 of Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Kharkhoda, District Sonipat.
2. Petitioner was earlier admitted to bail in the year 2019 and continued to appear before the trial Court. On 18.12.2023, his bail bonds were cancelled and non-bailable warrants were issued due to his non-appearance. Thereafter, petitioner surrendered himself on the next date of hearing, i.e. 16.01.2024 and is behind bars since then.
3. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was already on bail and thus there was no reason for him to evade trial and the conduct of the petitioner is evident from the fact that he himself

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surrendered before the trial Court on the very next date i.e. 16.01.2024.
By now, he has suffered incarceration of almost 02 months and has learnt his lesson.

4. State counsel is not in a position to dispute the aforesaid fact.

5. In view of above, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

6. Needless to say nothing recorded herein shall be construed to be an expression of an opinion on the merits of the case.
