1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 16.10.2023 passed in CWP-2307-2019.

2. Compliance report by way of affidavit of Yashendra Singh, Director, Sports Department, Haryana, Panchkula, filed in the Court today, is taken on record.

3. Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 16.10.2023 passed in CWP-2307-2019 has since been complied with and the representations filed by the petitioners have been decided by passing the speaking order dated 23.04.2024/26.04.2024 (Annexure R-1).

4. Counsel for the petitioners has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.



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5. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
6. However, the petitioners would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law, if they feel aggrieved of the order passed by the respondent/concerned authority.
