This petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No. 39 dated 04.03.2017 registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468 and 471 IPC at Police Station Moga City, District Moga and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom in view of peculiar facts and circumstances and legal position therein amounting to misuse and abuse of process of law, to meet end of justice.
2. At the outset, learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Gurdeep Singh submits that the present petition has been rendered infructuous as the petitioner has been acquitted by the learned trial Court on 29.11.2023.
