KARAMJIT SINGH, J. (Oral)

State counsel on instructions from SI Satnam Singh made statement that in pursuance to the cancellation report submitted by the police, learned trial Court has recorded statement of de-facto complainant/Amarjit Kaur and the said victim is having no objection if the cancellation report is accepted by the Court concerned. State counsel has produced copy of the said statement along with zimni order dated 8.4.2024 passed by the learned trial Court which are taken on record.

2. Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner made statement that the present petition be disposed of in light of the aforesaid statement made by the State counsel with liberty to the petitioner to revive the present petition in case any cause of action survives in future.

3. Counsel for the petitioner further submits that as FIR in question was registered in 2007, the trial Court be directed to take final decision on the cancellation report in an expeditious manner.

4. In view of above, the present petition is hereby dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty to the petitioner with further direction to the learned trial Court to finally dispose of the cancellation report submitted by the police by the next date fixed or within next 20 days thereof.
