1. Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned order dated 28.08.2019 (Annexure P-9) passed by respondent No.2 vide which the application filed by the petitioner under Sections 21 to 23 of the Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Act, 2007 has been dismissed and order dated 11.01.2022 (Annexure P-11) passed by respondent No.1 vide which the appeal filed by the petitioner against the said order dated 28.08.2019 has been dismissed.

2. Learned counsel appearing for respondent No.4 has submitted that the petitioner, who was a senior citizen, has died and the

present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in view of the stand taken by learned counsel for respondent No.4, the present petition be disposed of as having been rendered infructuous, at this stage, but prays that liberty be granted to the LRs of the petitioner to revive the petition in case any cause survives.

4. In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous, with the aforesaid liberty.
