Through the instant petition, as instituted under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C., the petitioner has sought the concession of his being enlarged on anticipatory bail, in case FIR No.18 dated 31.03.2023, under Sections 379-B (2) of IPC, and under Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Ghanie Ke Banger, District Batala.
2. On 07.03.2024, the petitioner was directed to join the investigation, and interim relief was also granted to the petitioner. However, the petitioner had failed to join the investigation, and thereupon on the request of learned counsel for the petitioner, one last opportunity was granted to the petitioner to join the investigation, vide order dated 02.04.2024.
3. Learned State counsel on instructions, imparted to him by ASI Sukhwinder Singh, submits that in view of the order (supra), the petitioner had

joined the investigation, but he did not co-operate with the Investigating Officer, as he has not got recovered the pistol, as well as the motorcycle, as directed by this Court, on the last date of hearing.

4. It seems that the petitioner is not co-operating, and is rather deliberately hampering the investigation, therefore, this Court deems it fit and appropriate to **dismiss** the instant petition, and the interim relief granted by this Court is hereby vacated.
