**SHEEL NAGU, C.J. (ORAL)**

1.            The present Public Interest Litigation has been filed raising the alleged public cause that construction of International Convention Centre, Sector 78, Faridabad has been entrusted to Executive Engineer, Haryana Shehari Vikash Pradhikaran (HSVP), Electrical Division, Faridabad, whereas it should have been entrusted to an Executive Engineer (Civil).

2.            Learned counsel for respondent No. 2 has filed a short reply by way of affidavit of the Secretary, HSVP, Panchkula in the Court today, which is taken on record, *inter-alia*, informing that the construction work of the said Convention Centre which was earlier entrusted to Executive Engineer (Electrical) was merely a stop gap arrangement and the same has now been entrusted to Executive Engineer (Civil), HSVP Division No. 5, Gurugram vide



order dated 18.07.2024. He submits that the petition as such has become infructuous.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute that the petition has become infructuous.

4. In view of the aforesaid facts, the petition stands dismissed as infructuous.
