On 11.03.2024, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Respondent Nos.2 & 3 were allowed anticipatory bail by this Court vide order dated 20.12.2023 passed in CRM-M-59118-2023, copy of which is Annexure P-8.

Petitioner is the complainant of the FIR in question and by way of this petition filed under Section 439(2) Cr.P.C. has prayed for cancellation of anticipatory bail.

Notice of motion to respondent No.1- State, for the time being.

Mr. Sahil R. Bakshi, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1- State.

Adjourned to 01.07.2024.

Respondent No.1- State to inform this Court as to whether respondent Nos.2 & 3 had joined the investigation in compliance of



order dated 20.12.2023 and as to whether their custodial interrogation is required for any purpose.”

Today, short reply has been filed by way of affidavit of Shri Gur Iqbal Singh, PPS, ACP (South) Ludhiana on behalf of the respondent- State.

Learned State Counsel has specifically informed that respondents No.2 and 3 had already joined the investigation. It is conceded by learned State Counsel that State never moved any application for cancellation of the anticipatory bail as granted to respondents No.2 and 3.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

No ground is made out to cancel the anticipatory bail as granted to respondents No.2 and 3.

Dismissed.
