1. Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of an appropriate writ, order or direction especially in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to depute the petitioner in the promotional Intermediate School Course forthwith.

2. On 26.09.2001, a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court was pleased to pass the following order: -

“It is stated by Mr. Sharma that the petitioner has been deputed to undergo Intermediate School Course which is going to be held on October, 2001.

In view of the above, adjourned to 17-1-2002.”

3. Learned State counsel has pointed out that in view of the said order, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.
