1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to pay him subsistence allowance during the period of suspension and permit him to join departmental proceedings.
2. The petitioner has raised various issues and made multiple prayers, however, during the course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner limit his prayers to direct the higher authorities to permit him to join departmental proceedings and pay him subsistence allowance.
3. Notice of motion.
4. Mr. Aman Dhir, DAG, Punjab accepts notice no behalf of the State.
5. With the consent of both sides, the matter is taken up for final disposal.
6. Learned State counsel assures the Court that petitioner would

be paid subsistence allowance within 30 days from today and he would be permitted to join departmental proceedings as well as duty as per law.

7. In the wake of statement of learned State counsel, the present petition stands disposed of with a direction to Commando, PAP, Jalandhar to make sure that petitioner is paid subsistence allowance within 30 days from today and he is further permitted to join departmental proceedings as well as duty in accordance with law. The petitioner at the first instance shall appear before Commando, PAP, Jalandhar tomorrow by 11:00 A.M.
