JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. By this common order CWP-8687-2000 and CWP-16660-2001 are disposed of since issues involved in the captioned petitions and prayer sought are common. With the consent of parties and for the sake of brevity, facts are borrowed from CWP-8687-2000.
2. The petitioners through instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India are seeking implementation of Award dated



20.12.1993 and 24.12.1993 passed by Labour Court.

3. Mr. Harsh Aggarwal, Advocate for respondent No.2 submits that respondent has already implemented the award. The petitioners filed contempt petition which also stand dismissed.
