1. The present Civil Revision Petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the order dated 21.10.2023 (Annexure P-7) passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Hisar as well as order dated 04.02.2020 (Annexure P-6) passed by JMIC, Hisar vide which the application under Section 19 of DV Act for seeking immediate residential accommodation in a shared household was dismissed.
2. It has been brought to the notice of this Court that vide order dated 22.10.2024, the Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Hisar has recorded the fact that the matter has been compromised and thus, the petitioner does not wish to pursue the case and accordingly, the case is dismissed as withdrawn and in view of the same, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such.
3. In view of the above, present Civil Revision Petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
4. Liberty is granted to the petitioners to revive the petition, in case, any cause of action survives.
