JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of award dated 11.12.1997 whereby Labour Court answered reference against the workman.

2. The operative portion of award reads as under:

“In the result, reference fails and is dismissed. However, it is ordered that if the respondents have to employ certain persons of the category of the workman or the like category, they acting under section 25H of the I.D. Act shall given notice to the workman and if he so desires, give him preference for the post.”

3. Mr. Ravi Dutt Sharma, Advocate for the petitioner submits that he has no instructions from his client.

4. The workman was terminated on 31.05.1988 and impugned



award was passed on 11.12.1997. There seems no reason to keep the matter pending.

5. Disposed of with liberty to petitioner to move an appropriate application within 3 months from today, if cause survives.

6. Pending misc. application (s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
