1. The present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents to release the benefit of 7th Pay Commission in favour of the petitioners with effect from 2016 and to release the benefit of third ACP to the petitioners on increased salary in view of the 7th Pay Commission along with arrears and interest @ 18% per annum from the due date till the date of payment and re-fixation with a further prayer to take a final decision on the legal notices dated 18.01.2023 (Annexure P-1), dated 17.01.2023 (Annexure P-2) and dated 09.01.2023 (Annexure P-3) filed by the petitioners, respectively, by passing a speaking order in a time bound manner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners had served legal notices dated 18.01.2023 (Annexure P-1), dated 17.01.2023 (Annexure P-2) and dated 09.01.2023 (Annexure P-3), respectively to

respondent No.3-Managing Director, Haryana Agro Industries Corporation Limited, Panchkula but the same have not been considered and decided till date. He further submitted that at this stage, the petitioners will be satisfied in case the aforesaid legal notices dated 18.01.2023 (Annexure P-1), dated 17.01.2023 (Annexure P-2) and dated 09.01.2023 (Annexure P-3) are considered and decided by respondent No.3-Managing Director, Haryana Agro Industries Corporation Limited, Panchkula in accordance with law and in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.
4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Samarth Sagar, Addl. A. G., Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of all the respondents. He submitted that in view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners, he has no objection in case time bound direction is issued in this regard.
5. In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, without calling for the reply from the respondents and without expressing anything on the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Managing Director, Haryana Agro Industries Corporation Limited, Panchkula to consider and decide the legal notices dated 18.01.2023 (Annexure P-1), dated 17.01.2023 (Annexure P-2) and dated 09.01.2023 (Annexure P-3) filed by the petitioners, respectively, strictly in accordance with law and within a period of three months from today.
