By filing the instant revision-petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner has sought the indulgence of this Court for the issuance of the direction to learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), S.A.S. Nagar, Mohali (for short ‘the Executing Court’) to decide *Execution Petition No.131 of 2021* titled as “*Balbir Singh versus Chief Secretary, Punjab*” in a time-bound manner, while averring that the same had been filed in July, 2021 but has not yet been decided.

- 3. The petitioner and his learned counsel restrict their prayer to the issuance of direction to the Executing Court to decide the afore-referred Execution Petition at the earliest possible.
