1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to grant him extension post his date of superannuation i.e. 30.09.2025.
2. The petitioner claims that there was seven years delay in making his appointment and he was not at fault. He joined service on 23.07.1999 and is going to retire on 30.09.2025. He has completed service of 24 years.
3. Mr. Madhur Singh, Advocate, at the outset, submits that grievance of the petitioner, at this stage, would be redressed if respondents are directed to consider his representation/legal notice dated 19.11.2023 (Annexure P-2) in accordance with law.

4. Without commenting upon merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent-authorities to decide representation/legal notice dated 19.11.2023 (Annexure P-2) of the petitioner in accordance with law and policy in force.
