ANOOP CHITKARA, J.

1. On the last date of hearing, following order was passed:-

“As per report of the Registry, respondent No.2 could not be served for want of correct address.

Given above, correct address of respondent No.2 be filed by 18.10.2024 failing which the Registry to list this matter on 23.10.2024 on which date the present petition shall be dismissed for non-prosecution.

However, on filing of correct address by the petitioner, fresh notice be issued to respondent No.2 for 17.01.2025.”

2. Today, counsel for the petitioner has expressed his inability to furnish correct address of respondent No.2. Counsel submits that her husband i.e. respondent No.2 is one of the party in Regular Second Appeal but they had no contact.

3. Be that as it may, previous order is not complied with.

4. Given above, the present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution with liberty to file fresh on being aware of the correct address of respondent No.2.

5. It is clarified that the time for which the petition was pending before this Court shall not be counted for the purpose of limitation and further petitioner shall be permitted to seek condonation of delay on the ground of non-availability of correct

address of respondent No.2. Closure of the petition shall not come in the way of the petitioner. All pending applications, if any also stands disposed of.
