1. Vide interim order dated 30.11.2022, the petitioner was granted the concession of interim bail till the final adjudication of the matter before the Trial Court.
2. Learned State counsel submits that in compliance of interim order passed by this Court, the petitioner has appeared before the Trial Court and he is regularly appearing before the Trial Court on each and every date of hearing. He further submits that out of 33 prosecution witnesses 15 prosecution witnesses have been examined and 07 witnesses have been given up being unnecessary.
3. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the interim order dated 30.11.2022 is made absolute and the present petition stands allowed. The petitioner shall continue to appear before the Trial Court on each and every date of hearing and shall not remain absent himself from the trial Court proceedings, without prior permission of the Court.
