Present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus for appointment of a warrant officer and to search for the detinue at the premises of respondent No.4 or any other place.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that on 01.03.2024 at 8:00 AM, the daughter of the petitioner went to the college and did not return back at home. Thereafter, the petitioner came to know that her daughter is missing with a boy namely Sam i.e. respondent No.4, who is forcing and blackmailing the detenue to marry with him and the detenue has been illegally confined by the private respondents.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Sandeep Kumar, DAG, Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on the asking of the Court and seeks time to file status report.

The present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3, to produce the detenue before the concerned jurisdictional Magistrate for the purpose of recording her statement and in case, the detenue deposes to live with her mother i.e. the petitioner, the detenue be released forthwith to join the

company of her mother and respondent No. 3 shall take action in accordance with law.
