The present criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of *habeas corpus* directing the official respondents to release the detenue, Jyoti, daughter of the petitioner from the hands of private respondent.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that the respondent No.4 has illegally confined the daughter of the petitioner.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Geeta Sharma, DAG, Haryana puts in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of official respondents-State.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the jurisdictional police authorities/police officers to produce the daughter of the petitioner before the concerned jurisdictional Magistrate for recording her statement. In case, she deposes to stay with the petitioner, she may be released forthwith. However, in case she deposes that she is staying with respondent No.4 out of her own will, she may be allowed to go with him.
