1. Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of directions to official respondents No. 1 to 4 to conduct fair and impartial investigation in FIR No. 144 dated 28.12.2023 registered under Sections 354, 354-A, 354-D, 506 and 509 of Indian Penal Code by a senior rank women police officer (not below the rank of Superintendent of Police).
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has taken a specific ground with regard to non citing of the material witnesses and the Investigating Agency has not completed the investigation in a free and fair manner and challan has been filed by projecting a one sided story in favour of the complainant.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner after arguing for some time, wishes to withdraw the present petition and seeks liberty to raise all the taken in the present petition including the plea of Section 173(8) of Cr.P.C. with regard to the investigation, at the appropriate stage during the course of trial.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
