1. The main writ petition is taken up for hearing today.
2. In the present writ petition, the challenge is to the charge-sheet issued to the petitioner on 08.01.2003. By an interim order dated 29.10.2004, the proceedings qua the said departmental enquiry were stayed. The petitioner must have retired by now.
3. Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner must have retired as of now and even while admitting the appeal, interim order was continued, allowing pending departmental proceedings to continue against a retired employee will be too harsh hence, the respondents are directed not to give effect to the charge-sheet any further qua the petitioner.
