1. The instant petition has been filed by the petitioners under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of certiorari/mandamus for quashing the impugned order of promotions dated 25.01.1999 as Annexure P-7 endorsed on 27.01.1999 and directing the respondents to consider and promote the petitioners as Branch Officers from the date their juniors were promoted.

2. It has been stated by the learned counsel for the parties that during the pendency of the present petition, the petitioner as well as respondent Nos.2 to 5 have already been retired from service on attaining the age of superannuation.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite his best efforts, he has not been able to get further instructions from the petitioner.

4. In this view of the matter, the present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution with liberty to the petitioner to revive the same, if any cause still survives.
