



3. Learned counsel for the respondent submits that the respondent undertakes that he would regularly produce the child for meeting in terms of the order dated 23.12.2020 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate First Class (Annexure P-3) without any failure except in case of any medical exigency of the child and on such days when child is having his examination in the school. In such event, advance intimation will be given to the respondent telephonically or through whatsapp message on her mobile phone.

4. In view of the above, the present petition stands disposed of having been compromised. However, the trial Court is requested to interact with the parties and the minor child in order to ascertain as to whether the meeting of the child can be fixed outside the Mediation and Conciliation Centre, Jalandhar so that the child may spend quality time with his mother-respondent and thereafter, the trial Court may consider to modify the order dated 23.12.2020 (Annexure P-3) with the mutual consent of the parties and keeping in view the best interest of the child.
