1. The present Civil Revision Petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the order dated 05.10.2021 (Annexure P-1) passed by Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.), Jalandhar vide which the application under Order 7 Rule 11 (b) (c) of CPC read with Section 7 of the Court Fee Act for rejection of the plaint filed by the petitioners has been dismissed.
2. It has been brought to the notice of this Court that vide order dated 03.09.2024, the main suit itself has been dismissed in default and thus, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
