By way of present revision petition, the petitioner has challenged the orders dated 05.08.2022, 03.11.2022, 01.12.2022, 09.01.2023, 08.02.2023, 03.03.2023, 11.04.2023, 15.05.2023, 13.07.2023, 09.08.2023, 06.09.2023, 06.10.2023, 14.11.2023, 16.01.2024 and 02.02.2024 passed by the trial Court, whereby the hearing of the application under Order 7 Rule 11 CPC has been repeatedly postponed and the same is pending since about two years.

2. Vide order dated 20.03.2024 of this Court, status report from the trial Court along with the reasons for the delay was called.

3. The status report has been received from Civil Judge (Junior Division) Chandigarh, wherein it has been submitted that the application under Order 7 Rule 11 CPC for rejection of the plaint was filed, on

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05.05.2022 and after filing of the reply to the said application, case was fixed for consideration on the said application. On 03.08.2022, another application under Order 8 Rules 1 and 10 read with Section 151 CPC was filed on behalf of the plaintiff. On 05.08.2022, reply to the said application was filed by defendant No.3 and then the case was adjourned for advancing arguments on application under Order 7 Rule 11 CPC. The arguments on the said application were advanced on behalf of defendant No.3. On 06.10.2023, the case was fixed for hearing the arguments on the said application on behalf of the plaintiff, thereafter, the case was adjourned time and again on request of the plaintiff for addressing of the arguments on the said application and now the date of hearing has been fixed as 10.05.2024 before the trial Court.

3. So keeping all this in view, that the application under Order 7 Rule 11 CPC was filed on 05.05.2022, which is still pending adjudication, the trial Court is directed to decide the application under Order 7 Rule 11 CPC expeditiously, in accordance with law, after hearing both the parties, preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

4. Revision petition is disposed of in the aforesaid terms.

5. All pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of accordingly.
