1. On 13.03.2024, the following order was passed by this

Court:-

“1. Through the instant petition, as instituted under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C., the petitioners have sought the concession of anticipatory bail, in case FIR No.07 dated 10.02.2024, under Sections 341, 323, 148, 149 of the IPC (Sections 324, 325, 308 of the IPC added subsequently), registered at P.S. Hajipur, District Hoshiarpur.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioners, in his asking for the relief (supra), has submitted that, though the petitioners have been falsely implicated in the present FIR, however, even if the allegations are taken to be a gospel truth, yet the injuries allegedly suffered by the injured at the hands of the petitioners, are simple in nature.

3. Lastly, the learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, except the present FIR, the petitioners are not involved in any other case, and, they are ready to join the investigation and to cooperate with the investigating officer.

4. Notice of motion for 22.04.2024.

5. Mr. Pardeep Bajaj, D.A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

6. In the meantime, the petitioners are directed to join the investigation and to appear before the investigating agency, as and when called upon to do so. In the event of their arrest, they shall be admitted to interim bail on their furnishing bail bonds to

the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioners shall abide by the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

7. To be heard with CRM-M-11894-2024. ”

2. Learned State counsel, on instructions imparted to him by ASI Harbhajan Singh, submits that the petitioners have already joined the investigation in pursuance to the aforesaid order, and they have fully co-operated with the investigation process, and are no more required for any further custodial investigation.

3. In view of the specific stand taken by the learned State counsel, the present petition is **allowed**, and order dated 13.03.2024 is, hereby, made absolute, on the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
