1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the orders dated 13.12.2023 and 19.01.2024 passed in CWP-27933-2023.
2. It is not even in dispute that even the maximum period of the contract awarded to the petitioner has been over, by now. Therefore, it would not be appropriate to proceed further in the contempt proceedings.
3. Dismissed.
4. However, mere dismissal of the present petition would not be taken as adverse to any claim of the petitioner, if it avails any other alternate remedy on the basis of the orders passed by the Writ Court.
