AMAN CHAUDHARY, J.

1. The present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a direction to the respondents to release the payment of Rs.1,77,437/- regarding medical reimbursement on account the treatment of the petitioner alongwith interest thereon @ 12% p.a.
2. Learned State counsel contends that the claim of the medical reimbursement could not be processed only on account of the fact that there were certain documents that were lacking, which the petitioner had not furnished.
3. Learned counsel for the LR's of the petitioner, on instructions, submits that the needful shall be done within a period of 15 days.
4. In view of the above, learned State counsel on instructions of Mr. Sarbjeet Singh, LA, who is present in Court, submits that the LR's should appear before the District Education Officer (Secondary), Faridabad on or before 26.02.2024. Upon submission of the requisite documents, the necessary payment

in accordance with rules, shall be released within a further period of 4 weeks.

5. The present petition is disposed of accordingly.
6. In case, any part of the claim is not accepted, a speaking order shall be passed regarding the same.
