Prayer in the present petition is for quashing the ROR No.201/2022 dated 18.04.2022 (Annexure P-12) and order dated 21.04.2022 (Annexure P-13) passed by the Court of Financial Commissioner, Haryana in ROR No.201/2022 filed by Municipal Corporation Panchkula which is not maintainable as the land in question has become the part of the Municipal Corporation, Panchkula on the merger of Gram Panchayat, Manikya in the Municipal Corporation, Panchkula, after issuance of notification dated 17.03.2010 issued by the Urban Local Bodies Department, Haryana and upon merger of Gram Panchayat, Manikya the land comes under the jurisdiction of Municipal Corporation, Panchkula and the land in dispute is no longer amenable to provisions of the Panchayat Act or the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulations) Act, 1961. Further prayer has been made for directing the Financial Commissioner, Revenue Haryana to take decision on the application filed by the petitioner on dated 08.08.2023 (Annexure P-14) for dismissal of ROR No.201/2022 MC, Panchkula Vs. Divisional Commissioner Ambala and others in time bound manner as for the last two years no proceedings have taken place after the issuance of stay

order dated 21.04.2022 (Annexure P-13) in favour of MC Panchkula in *malafide* manner.

Precise submissions made by counsel for the petitioner is that the appeal filed by the petitioner is pending adjudication before respondent No.1. He submits that despite various dates from last two years no hearing has taken place in the appeal.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Upasana Dhawan, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the State. She on instructions from has submitted that the revision is fixed for hearing before respondent No.1 on 18.04.2024.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.1-Financial Commissioner, Haryana to hear the revision on the date fixed i.e. 18.04.2024 and decide the same expeditiously, preferably, within three months, from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
