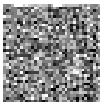

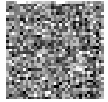

CWP-7419-2021

At the outset, Mr. B. R. Mahajan, Advocate General, Haryana
submitted that the petitioner will be granted appointment under the General
category by passing an order within a period of one month from today and he
will be granted all the benefits of seniority, pay fixation etc. from the date when
similarly situated candidates had been appointed except for the arrears of pay.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that in view of the
statement made by the Advocate General, Haryana, the present writ petition
may be disposed of as having become infructuous.

Ordered accordingly.

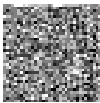
CWP-12933-2024

At the outset, Mr. B. R. Mahajan, Advocate General, Haryana
submitted that so far as the present writ petition is concerned, the impugned
order dated 24.05.2024 (Annexure P-10) will be withdrawn by passing an order

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within a period of one month from today and therefore, the present writ petition has become infructuous and the same may be disposed of accordingly.
