Vide order dated 23.07.2024 on the basis of the statement made by learned counsel for the appellants a proposal was made for enhancing compensation by Rs.7,78,000/- over and above the amount already granted by the MACT concerned. Today, learned counsel for the State along with Mr. Ajay Dalal, GM, Haryana Roadways has stated by pointing out that there was some miscalculation in the interest part and with the revised, the total enhancement comes to Rs.6,36,048/- and has agreed to enhance the compensation only by Rs.6,36,048/- and not by Rs.7,78,000/- and has signed to that effect. Learned counsel for the appellants has agreed to this counter offer of the respondent No.2-Haryana Roadways.

We dispose of this case with a direction to the Haryana Roadways to deposit a crossed-cheque in the sum of Rs.6,36,048/- (Rupees Six Lakh Thirty Six Thousand and Forty Eight only) in the name of the appellant No.1- Bhateri Devi with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 07.01.2025 failing which the amount will carry 9% interest p.a. From the date of this order till the cheque is deposited with the office of the Lok Adalat. The appellant's counsel/appellant may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order/statement be supplied /sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the High Court.
