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JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J (ORAL)

1. On 24.03.2005, the following order was passed:

*“The petitioner-Management has filed the present application wherein it has been averred that the petitioners are ready and willing to take back the respondent-workman in service. It has further been submitted that the Management is ready to pay the current salary to the workman.*

*Counsel for the respondent-workman does not have any instructions in this regard.*

*However, keeping in view the fact that the petitioners are ready and willing to take back the respondent-workman in service on current wages without prejudice to their rights in the writ petition, it is ordered that the respondent-workman may join the services of the petitioners within a period of two weeks from today. The respondent shall be paid the current wages.*

*C.M. disposed of.”*

2. Mr. Mansur Ali, Advocate submits that he has no contact with his client.

3.           There seems to be no reason to keep the matter pending, especially in view of the afore-stated order dated 24.03.2005.
4.           Disposed of with liberty to petitioner to move an appropriate application within 3 months from today, if cause survives.
5.           Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
