Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking setting aside of the order dated 05.05.2017 (Annexure P-6) passed by learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Mukerian, whereby the petitioner has been declared as proclaimed offender in case bearing FIR No. 38 dated 24.06.2016, lodged for offence under Section 498-A of the Indian Penal Code 1860 at Police Station Talwara, District Hoshiarpur.

This Court vide order dated 07.05.2022, had directed the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court and join the proceedings.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has complied with the order dated 07.05.2022.

However, learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Ram Singh submits that petitioner has been concealing himself and has absconded and as such he has been again declared as proclaimed offender by the concerned Court below.

In view of the above, the present petition is hereby dismissed,
being devoid of any merit.
