KARAMJIT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

1. The present petition was dismissed against petitioner No.1 vide order dated 19.03.2024.
2. Counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of the previous orders, petitioners No.2 and 3 have joined the investigation with the police. Counsel for petitioners No.2 and 3 further submits that as per the affidavit of Inspector Navdeep Singh which is submitted today in the Court, offence under Section 307 IPC has been deleted.
3. Report by way of affidavit of Inspector Navdeep Singh, SHO, Police Station Dharamkot, District Moga filed on behalf of the State is taken on record along with Annexures R-1 to R-3.
4. The State counsel on instructions from ASI Jaswinder Singh submits that petitioners No.2 and 3 have joined investigation with the police

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and also got the recovery effected of the weapons used in commission of crime and are not required by the police for any further investigation in this case. The State counsel has not disputed the fact that offence under Section 307 IPC is already deleted during the investigation of this case.

5. The present petition is vehemently resisted by learned counsel for the complainant but he has not disputed the fact that as per the affidavit of Inspector Navdeep Singh which is filed today on behalf of the State, offence under Section 307 IPC stands deleted.

6. In light of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed qua petitioners No.2 and 3 and orders of interim bail dated 12.03.2024 and 19.03.2024 are made absolute. However, both the said petitioners are to abide by the conditions as are provided in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
