1. In the present writ petition, the grievance being raised by the petitioner is that 3rd ACP for which the petitioner was entitled for upon rendering 24 years of service, has not been released to him though there is no impediment hence, the respondents are liable to be directed to grant the petitioner the benefit of 3rd ACP w.e.f. 01.08.2022 along with consequential benefits.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the grievance raised in the present petition has already been raised by the petitioner in the legal notice dated 18.12.2023 (Annexure P-7) which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said legal notice by passing an appropriate speaking order.

4. Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.
5. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case the legal notice dated 18.12.2023 (Annexure P-7) has been received in the concerned office and is still pending consideration, the same will be decided by the authorities concerned within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of copy of this order.
6. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
7. Ordered accordingly.
