1. The petitioners have filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to count the services of the petitioners rendered by them on adhoc basis before the regularization of their services as Clerks/Tractor Drivers for the purpose of pensionary/retiral benefits and furthermore they be held entitled to receive pensionary benefits as per the Old G.P.F. Scheme.
2. Learned counsel for the parties are ad idem that the present writ petition is covered by the judgment passed by the Division Bench of this Court in CWP No.2371 of 2010, titled as '*Harbans Lal Vs. State of Punjab*', decided on 31.08.2010 as well as in LPA No.666 of 2022 and other connected appeals, titled as '*Municipal Council, Qadian Vs. Musthaq Maish and others*', decided on 21.12.2023.
4. Consequently, the instant writ petition is allowed in the same terms as in CWP No.2371 of 2010.
