1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 read with Section 10 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 29.11.2023 passed in Civil Suit No.42 of 2023.
2. Since the order qua which the non-compliance is complained, is passed by the Civil Court and that Court is having sufficient powers to deal with any disobedience, therefore, this Court does not deem it appropriate to interfere in the matter.
3. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
4. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail any other remedy before the same Court which has passed the order dated 29.11.2023, seeking compliance of the same.
