The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondent-Authorities not to effect recovery to the tune of Rs.8,15,713/- as alleged in the affidavit attached with the Review petition (Annexure P-3) filed by the respondent-authorities in CWP No. 26 of 2002 on 21.08.2002; to give directions to refund a sum of Rs.1,92,000/- which has been wrongly and illegally adjusted against the alleged due amount of Rs.8,15,713/-; and to give directions to release the pensionary benefits and other due amount to the petitioner.
2. There was no representation on behalf of the petitioner on 02.03.2020, 30.07.2024 and 02.09.2024. Even today also, position is the same.

Learned State counsel submit that in view of the order dated **28.09.2001** passed by this Court in ***RSA No.1656 of 1985*** titled as ***The State of Haryana and another Versus Shyam Sunder and*** order dated **07.08.2002** passed in ***Civil Revision No.1475 of 2002*** titled as ***Sham Sunder Versus State of Haryana***, nothing survives in the present petition.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of accordingly.
