1. The petitioner is seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.2 to 4 to conduct a fair and impartial investigation in the complaint No.1283-PTM dated 10.04.2023 (Annexure P-1) filed by him and to initiate legal action on the same.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite approaching the authorities concerned time and again, they have been sitting over the matter. He submits that as recently as on 04.03.2024 the petitioner has again made a representation to the police authorities but in vain. He submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar (Rural), Police Commissionerate, Jalandhar, to look into the representations of the petitioner and take appropriate action in accordance with law.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On asking of the Court, Mr. Navdeep Singh, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.

5. In view of the restricted prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of with directions to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar (Rural), Police Commissionerate, Jalandhar, to look into the representations (Annexures P-1 and P-3) of the petitioner and take immediate appropriate action, if required, in accordance with law.
