1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 09.02.2022 passed in CWP-1449-2022.
2. Counsel for the respondents has submitted that services of the petitioner already stood terminated well before the date of status quo order passed by the Writ Court in the writ petition filed by the petitioner. The aforesaid order was passed by the Writ Court on 09.02.2022, whereas, the petitioner was never in service after June, 2021.
3. Counsel for the petitioner has failed to produce any material to show that he was in service as on the date of passing of the order by the Writ Court.
4. In view of the above, this Court does not find it appropriate to continue with the present petition any more.
5. Dismissed.
6. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
